

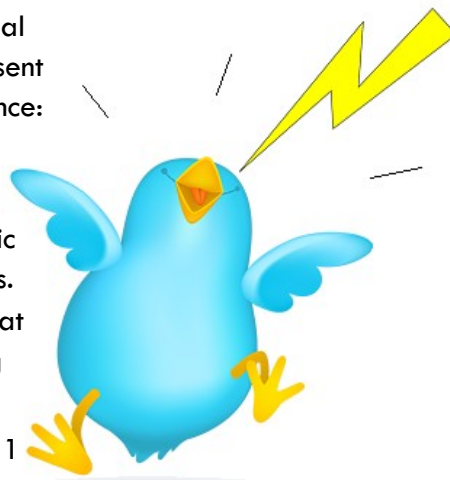


# The Library as Space & Place
