- Sarah Trancansky shared that their enrollment has increased and that is making things busy in the library.
- Deb shared that there isn't anything new though ILL is very busy right now.
- Caitlin had nothing new to share.
- Sarah Shank shared that they are training front desk circulation students
- Virgilio shared that he's been busy with changes to ILL
- I shared that there is a lot going on and the two big ones are agenda items.
- Gregg shared that they have seen a very large increase in printing, mostly from students and it's due to a new printing system which doesn't limit the number of prints for anyone including students so students are printing text books and other items. The new system is provided by SUNY and he anticipates that there will be limits placed on printing during the Summer but for now, there won't be limits. Virgilio shared that they limit printing by students. Gregg also shared that the Technology Department has been sharing their space and this has caused some issues with their hours of operation. At the start of the semester, they were open limited hours but due to the Technology departments hours getting expanded, they have had to work out how to expand the library hours too.

BARC Transition Update
