



Report from the SCRLC Nominating Committee

The SCRLC Board of Trustees Nominating Committee presents the following nominations for Board of Trustees for terms beginning in 2023

Megan Biddle, Four County Library System, for a second term, 2023-2027.

Megan Biddle joined the Four County Library System in 2009 and has overseen the Collection Services Department since then. The department is made up of the consolidated Acquisitions Cataloging and Physical Processing for the Four County Library System. She spearheaded the incorporation of e-books and downloadable audio and continues to play a major role in the ongoing development of e-resources. Megan received her Master in Library Science and Information Science through Drexel University.

Erika Jenns, Southern Tier Library System, for a first term, 2023-2027.

Erika Jenns is the Engagement Consultant for the Southern Tier Library System, where she provides web development and design support for 48 member libraries, oversees marketing of system services, provides training for member library staff, and manages system digital collections. Originally from Indiana, she received her MLS with a specialization in Rare Books and Manuscripts Librarianship from Indiana University, along with an MA in English, with a focus on 19th-Century American Literature and Digital Humanities. Erika previously worked as the Scholarly Engagement Librarian in the Reference Department of the Indiana University Libraries. There, she coordinated and facilitated an array of programming for graduate students. Erika is actively engaged in committee work through the Public Library Association Sustainability Round Table and the Digital Literacy Committee, along with the New Yorkers for Better Libraries Political Action Group.

David Schuster, Binghamton University, for a first full term, 2023-2027.

David Schuster has been working at Binghamton University leading various units over the last 6 years. A few of the departments he has lead are Special Collections and Preservation, Technical Services (Cataloging and Acquisitions), Technology, and Digital Initiatives which includes Scholarly Communications and Digital Scholarship. In his 30 year library career he has worked in and been involved with School Libraries, Public Libraries, and Academic libraries, and worked for a vendor, making him a well-rounded individual for concerns that are relevant to all types of libraries.
