## Final Report, Digitizing GOHS's Women's History Collection

The Digitizing GOHS's Women's History Collection remains in progress. GOHS applied for a second-round of funding through SCRLC to complete the project and compensate for unforeseen changes in project management and equipment purchases.

Consultant Christina Milliman assessed GOHS' archival collections chosen for digitization and delivered her review of the collection(s) and recommendations for digitization equipment. GOHS purchased our digitization equipment in the fall of 2021.

To date, approximately 200 hours of digitization work on the Women's History Collection has been completed. GOHS anticipates completing the digitization work for this project with our second round of funding, granted in 2022. The materials digitized so far have been uploaded to the NYS Heritage database.
