

# Hospital Library Services Program Advisory Committee Meeting Wednesday, November 17, 2021 at 11 AM

1. October meeting minutes – approved.

# 2. OVID Package 2021-2022

- a. The committee reviewed the pricing for the OVID package with quotes for a package containing *The Journal of Urology* and one without this title (as usage stats have been incredibly low for it). The committee agreed not to continue a subscription to *The Journal of Urology*.
- b. The OVID package this year will revert to the 30/70 split, with SCRLC paying 30% and participating hospitals dividing up the remaining 70%.
- c. The breakdown for the package without *The Journal of Urology* is as follows:
  - i. If Auburn does not participate in the subscription, the total cost would be \$15,051. The 70/30 split would cost each institution \$2634 and SCRLC would pay \$4515.
  - ii. If Auburn does participate in the package, there is a 10% increase in cost, and divided 5 ways, the cost for each institution would be \$2318, while SCRLC would pay \$4967.
  - iii. Both options save us money from the previous year.
- d. Molly will request an invoice from OVID once we determine if Auburn will be joining the package.

# 3. Marketing Activities

a. The committee reviewed the draft Marketing Plan for HLSP. Although it was approved, many on the committee felt marketing is very difficult with hospitals these days and even our librarians at certain institutions find that the outreach work they do is frequently overlooked.
