 Additionally, there is an electronic resources cost share fee for governing members, which is set by the Board of Trustees. Currently, individual governing members pay \$112; library systems, \$561. Individual public library members do not pay the cost share because they access the resources through their public library system. The cost share is approximately 10% of the Council's electronic resources expenditures.
